Students are required to complete a total of 45 credit hours to be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in Economics.



➔ Eligibility and Qualifications

- A person who has completed or is expected to have completed at least 12 years of formal education before enrollment, or a person who has completed the entire course secondary education at the time of application.
- A non-Korean national whose parents are both non-Korean nationals.
- A person who meets at least one of the following language proficiency requirements (TOEFL, IELTS, and New-TEPS)

➔ Scholarship

Category	Eligibility	Details
First semester Scholarship	Students who satisfy the minimum language test score	Qualified students receive a 30% - 80% tuition reduction for the 1st semester. It is a 30% reduction if the student is from a country whose mother tongue is in the English language.
GPA Based Scholarship	Students whose GPA of the previous semester is 3.5 or higher and had successfully taken at least 15 course credits	Qualified students receive a 20% - 50% tuition reduction for the next semesters.
