► Eligibility and Qualifications

- A bachelor's degree from a four-year university based either in or outside of Korea, or is expected to receive a bachelor's degree before admission into the program.
- Applicants who already received a Master's degree are also welcomed.
- Applicants who meet at least one of the following language proficiency requirements.
- Applicants who the advisor-to-be determines to be in possession of the ability to carry out research and obtains the department head's approval to submit the Letter of Verification of Research Capability.

Program Requirements & Courses

Students in the MPA program are required to successfully complete a total 30 credit hours over 5 semesters, and pass the comprehensive exam in their penultimate semester.

※ The optional master's thesis counts for six of these 30 credit hours.

Eight courses are designated as Core Courses, with two offered each semester in rotation. In addition to these Core Courses, students can choose from Elective Courses, or courses offered by other graduate programs at Sejong, such as Global Affairs, Hospitality & Tourism Management, or the MBA program.
